# Level 5 Diploma CHAPLAINCY

The Diploma in Chaplaincy is a foundational level programme in Christian Studies tailored towards those who are intending to minister as chaplains in the community. This programme enables students to complete the New Zealand Diploma in Christian Studies (Level 5) with a strand in Chaplaincy. The Diploma is a combination of delivery through intensives of 3 and 4-day duration and distance education/e-learning or campus studies.

#### Course Structure:

Narrative of the First Testament (15 credits) Writings of the New Testament (15 credits) Understanding the Faith (15 credits) Communicating the Gospel (15 credits) Chaplaincy Practice 1 (30 credits) Chaplaincy Practice 2 (30 credits)

#### Length Of Programme

Full-Time: 1 Year (4 papers per semester) Part-Time: Up to 4 Years (average of 2 papers per semester)
